

# 2016 CEV BEACH VOLLEYBALL CONTINENTAL TOUR – ZONAL EVENT ORGANISING TERMS & CONDITIONS



EVENT	
<b>Event name</b>	"Zonal Association" Continental Tour-Zonal Event
<b>Application forms</b>	Duly completed BV-A2 and Zonal Tour Homologation forms
<b>Application deadline</b>	Min. 45 days before the event
<b>Competition Dates</b>	To be coordinated and approved by the CEV
<b>Number of events</b>	Max. 5 events per gender per Zonal Association, with a quota of max. 3 during the summer period (April to mid-September) plus max. 2 during the winter period (Mid-September to March). Max. 1 event per gender per National Federation
EVENT CONDITIONS	
<b>Venue, Facilities &amp; Court Equipment</b>	Set by the organising Zonal Association and in line with FIVB Official Beach Volleyball Rules. Ball homologated by FIVB
<b>Competition duration</b>	Min. 2 days
<b>Participating teams</b>	Min. 12 team Main Draw with a min. participation of 3 National Federations. Participating NFs must be affiliated to the respective Zonal Association
<b>Prize Money</b>	Up to a maximum of 5'000.- EUR per gender per event
<b>Registration Procedure / Forms</b>	Mandatory usage of CEV/FIVB online registration system and of CEV BV-01 Players Commitment and Health Certificate form. CEV License fee of 20-EUR per athlete (once per season)
ORGANISERS OBLIGATIONS	
<b>Zonal Association</b>	Assign a contact person to collaborate for all competition related issues with CEV. Appoint one Technical Supervisor per event, with good knowledge of the CEV and Zonal Association Competition Regulations, that will coordinate the competition and report to the Zonal Association/CEV after the event. Enforce the FIVB official Beach Volleyball Rules
<b>National Federation/ Organiser</b>	Submit the assigned to the event referees through BV-LR form to CEV. Following a CEV BoA decision and with the approval of the respective Zonal Association, 50% of the assigned to the event referees should be International BV referees/Candidates. Assign a CEV/FIVB Referee Delegate or an FIVB International Beach Volleyball Referee to act as the event's Referee Delegate. Assign a VIS manager for the competition software with a good understanding of Beach Volleyball competitions and a solid IT background. Forward a preview and a daily report at the end of each competition day to the CEV Communication Department, accompanied with photos
<b>Post Event Report</b>	Send a post event report including results, rankings, photos and sample of all printed materials the latest 1 month after the event
ORGANISERS BENEFITS	
<b>TV rights</b>	National TV rights
<b>FIVB/CEV Ranking Points</b>	Yes, in case all terms and conditions are fulfilled
<b>Comp. Software (VIS)</b>	Yes, mandatory usage for the allocation of FIVB/CEV ranking points
MARKETING & PROMOTION	
<b>Television production</b>	In case of TV Production this must follow the guidelines of the CEV and the TV signal should be available and free of charge to CEV/TV agency
<b>Promotional Productions</b>	Use of the CEV Marks in all publications and promotional activities following CEV approval.
<b>Panels, Flags and Backdrops</b>	Three 3 CEV/CEV Campaign panels in each court in pre-determined positions, plus 1 CEV flag in a predominant position in the venue/tribune. Materials to be produced by the organizers, according to CEV Marketing Regulations and Guidelines.
